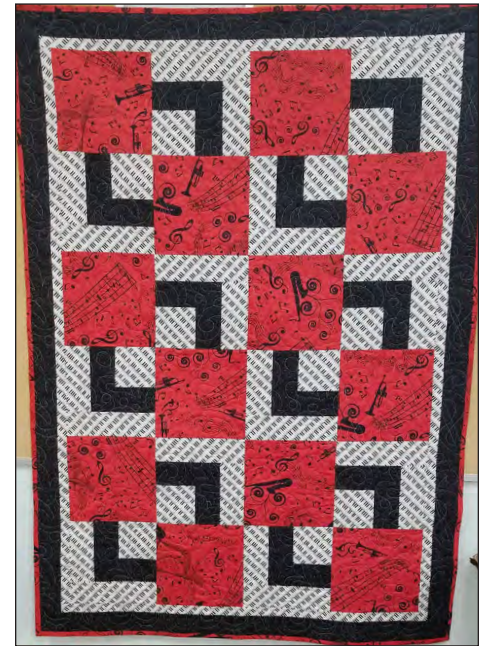

4. *Again Yeva's Quilt-as-you-go* ✂

Join this class to learn how to create a double-sided quilt with no quilting hassles. This technique is simple and easy to follow. It is a good-to-know method for any beginner or accomplished quilter. Apply this technique to any desirable quilt built from same or different block sizes. This technique enables you to work with small pieces while working on a project of any size. You make quilted sandwiches of the blocks and I will teach you how to sew them together. The class will provide you with knowledge and ideas. The demos of ready quilts will help you in your creativity.

In this class you will learn a *quilt-as-you-go* technique to complete your t-shirt quilt. Combine backing, batting, t-shirt and quilting in one step. Have way too many t-shirts? This process is a great way to make a double-sided t-shirt quilt. You will be amazed how fast your quilt will come together.

8. The Freezer Paper Appliqué Method - Circles & Curves ✂

Participants of the class will learn how to use freezer paper for the hand appliqué. Differences between “freezer paper on the top” and “freezer paper on the bottom” will be demonstrated and explained. A heart will be the practice piece in class. Then students will make curves (grape vines), circles (grapes) and leaves for the given pattern. Along with this technique, other ways of hand and machine appliqué will be introduced. No special sewing skills are required for this class.
